## **Overview**

This bill establishes requirements for certain private contracts awarded by the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT).

### **Section**

- 1 Contracts for trunk highways. Establishes contract review and reporting requirements for certain contracts between MnDOT and a private contractor for supplies and materials related to trunk highway construction and maintenance.
  - **Subd. 1. Privatization transportation contracts.** Defines privatization transportation contracts as an agreement between the Commissioner of Transportation and a private contractor to provide supplies, materials, or work incidental to trunk highway construction or maintenance projects.
  - **Subd. 2. Applicability.** Applies the bill's requirements to any eligible private contract for \$25,000 or more.
  - **Subd. 3. Review of contract costs.** Requires the Commissioner to prepare two comprehensive estimates of trunk highway project costs: (1) if the project is done by MnDOT, and (2) if it is done by the proposed recipient of the contract. Allows the Commissioner to enter into a contract for \$250,000 or more only if:
    - the contract costs are at least 10 percent below the costs if the project is

done by MnDOT;

- the quality of the work and services will meet or exceed the quality if the project is done by MnDOT; and
- the contract is in the public interest.

**Subd. 4. Reports.** Requires the Commissioner to provide, annually by September 1, a report to the legislature listing privatization contracts and identifying project details, cost estimates, actual costs, and the Commissioner's determination on meeting contract requirements.

**Subd. 5. Short title.** Refers to the bill as the "Taxpayers' Transportation Accountability Act."
