This bill appropriates \$2 million from the general fund to the town road sign replacement program. The appropriation can be used as the local match for any federal funds, and is available until July 1, 2009.

The town road sign replacement program was established by the 2005 Legislature, but is not effective until there is an appropriation from state or federal funds. Program tasks include inventorying county and town road signs; evaluating their compliance with road sign standards; removing, purchasing, and installing new signs; and, establishing an ongoing sign maintenance program.
