Special contracts; bordering states. Amends § 245.50, subdivision 5, by adding paragraph (f). Provides that if a Minnesota resident is admitted to a facility for mental health treatment in a bordering state, specific licensed practitioners in that state may act as examiners. Requires these individuals to have received training on the provisions of the Minnesota civil commitment statute, chapter 253B.
