Overview

This bill creates the crime of tampering with gas and electrical lines. It makes it a 20-year felony to intentionally and without claim of right take, remove, break, or sever a line that is used for supplying or transporting gas or electricity without consent and in a manner that creates a substantial risk of death or bodily harm or serious property damage.
