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## Overview

This bill exempts children from the requirement that MinnesotaCare enrollees have no health coverage for at least four months prior to application and renewal. Under MinnesotaCare, children are defined as individuals under age 21. The bill does not exempt children from the requirement that they have no other health coverage while enrolled in MinnesotaCare.

## Section

- **1 General requirements.** Amends § 256L.07, subd. 1. Makes a conforming change related to elimination of the MinnesotaCare four-month uninsured requirement for children.
- 2 **Other health coverage.** Exempts children from the requirement that MinnesotaCare enrollees have no health coverage for at least four months prior to application and renewal.
