Appropriates \$6,458,000 in each year of the next biennium to the commissioner of corrections to reimburse counties for housing short-term felons committed to the custody of the Commissioner. Permits the Commissioner to use up to 20% of the appropriation for inpatient medical care. Caps the per-day reimbursement rate at \$70. Requires proportional distribution of funds to counties. Authorizes the Commissioner to house short-term offenders in state correctional facilities.
