### Section

- 1** **Contracts with certain entities prohibited.** Prohibits the Commissioner of Administration or a government agency from entering into contracts with entities who within the prior five years have been convicted of offenses relating to contracts, antitrust laws, or other specified crimes, or with entities who have paid federal or state agencies more than \$1 million to settle allegations of improper billing, collusion, failure to disclose relevant information, or bid rigging.

Effective January 1, 2008, requires applicants for state contracts to certify they have not had convictions specified in this section.

Requires commissioners and government agencies to terminate existing contracts with entities that had convictions specified in this section within five years of entering into the contract.

Provides that this section is repealed June 30, 2009.
