Overview

Allows a parent to request that school personnel administer physician-prescribed naturopathic medications to a student.

Section

- 1** **Applicability.** (a) Allows parents to request that school personnel administer physician-prescribed naturopathic medications, among other medications.

(b) Defines "physician-prescribed naturopathic medicine" as naturopathic medicine under the federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act that is prescribed by a licensed physician in consultation with a board certified naturopathic physician.
- 2** **Labeling.** Requires drugs and medicine, except physician-prescribed and labeled naturopathic medicine, to be in a labeled container prepared by a pharmacist.

Makes this section effective immediately.
- 3** **Administration.** Requires physician-prescribed naturopathic medicine to be administered according to the order of the prescribing physician.

Makes this section effective immediately.
