Appropriates \$400,000 to the Commissioner of Corrections to fund a two-year offender re-entry pilot project. The pilot project shall help offenders leaving state prisons by developing holistic plans for successful reintegration. The pilot project shall include a re-entry panel consisting of persons with a stake in successful offender re-entry. The panel is responsible for providing assistance and guidance to offenders who participate in the pilot project.

Requires the commissioner to submit a report to the legislature on the results of the pilot project by January 15, 2010.
