Overview

School districts and other participants in the school meals program receive federal money and commodities for school breakfast and school lunches. Minnesota's school funding formulas provide additional funding for school meals. Under current law, the state pays an additional 10.5 cents for each school lunch served to a student.

This bill raises the state aid payment by an additional 1.5 cents to 12 cents per meal for each school lunch served.

Section

- **School lunch aid computation.** Pays a program participant an additional 1.5 cents per meal for each school lunch served.
- **Appropriation.** Appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund to the commissioner of education to pay for the aid authorized in section 1.
