Overview

This bill designates a Hennepin County nonprofit mental health agency as an essential community provider.

Section

Application. Amends § 62Q.19, subd. 2. Instructs the commissioner to accept an application for designation as an essential community provider until June 30, 2007, from one applicant that is a nonprofit community mental health agency in Hennepin County that works with the Minneapolis public schools to provide mental health services to school-age children and their families and to provide mental health services to immigrant communities.

This section is effective the day following final enactment.
