Requires the neighborhood revitalization policy board to evaluate the need for continued funding and report by October 15, 2007, to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over the program. Requires the report to make recommendations based on a commitment of at least \$400 million for the program between 1990 and 2029.

Under Minnesota Statutes, section 469.1831, subdivision 6, paragraph (c), "Each city that develops a program must establish a policy board whose membership includes members of the city council, county board, school board, and citywide library and park board where they exist appointed by the respective governing bodies; the mayor or designee of the mayor; and a representative from the city's house of representatives delegation and a representative from the city's state senate delegation appointed by the respective delegation. The policy board may also include representatives of citywide community organizations, neighborhood organizations, business owners, labor, and neighborhood residents. The elected officials and appointed members of the library board who are members of the policy board may appoint the other members of the board."
