Overview

This bill expands the crime of second-degree burglary to include unlawfully entering a government building, religious establishment, historic property, or school building, and committing or intending to commit the crime of theft or criminal damage to property. The maximum penalty for second-degree burglary is 10 years imprisonment and/or a \$20,000 fine.
