Overview

The Minnesota Humanities Commission is a nonprofit organization. In 2005, the omnibus education funding bill contained an appropriation of \$400,000 per year, as a part of the best practices grants, for the Commission to offer professional development seminars for K-12 educators. The seminars are designed to advance the study of the humanities in specific content areas and to connect teachers with both research-based classroom resources and high-quality scholarship.

The base budget includes \$400,000 per year for the Minnesota Humanities Commission. This bill increases the annual appropriation to \$1.75 million.
