Overview

Makes a student who enrolls in a nonresident district under the state's open enrollment program eligible to participate in all academic courses and athletic, extracurricular, and cocurricular activities on the same basis as resident students enrolled in the district. Repeals the statutory provision directing the Minnesota state high school league to adopt rules and regulations governing the athletic participation of students who attend school in a nonresident district under open enrollment.

Section

1 **Participation in academic courses and other activities.** Makes a student who enrolls in a nonresident district under the state's open enrollment program immediately eligible to participate in all academic courses, athletic activities, extracurricular activities, and cocurricular activities on the same basis as resident students enrolled in the district.

Makes this section effective immediately and applicable to students who enroll under the state's open enrollment program in the 2007-2008 school year and later.

2 **Repealer.** Repeals MS, section 128C.02, subdivision 5, directing the league to adopt rules and regulations governing the athletic participation of students who attend school in a nonresident district under open enrollment.

Makes this section effective immediately and applicable to the 2007-2008 school year.
