This bill clarifies that the registration period for a predatory offender restarts if that person is (1) arrested for a new offense prior to the end of the person's registration period and subsequently convicted and incarcerated, whether the conviction and incarceration occur after the initial registration period ends or not; or (2) determined to have violated probation, parole, supervised release, or conditional release prior to the end of the person's registration period and subsequently incarcerated whether the incarceration occurs after the initial registration period ends or not.

For purposes of § 243.166, subdivision 6, the term "incarcerated" includes credit for time served prior to a conviction or supervised release revocation.
