This bill permits a court to include provisions in an order for protection: (1) directing for the care, possession, or control of a pet or companion animal; and (2) prohibiting the respondent from physically abusing or injuring any pet, without legal justification, as an indirect means of intentionally threatening the safety of such person. The bill applies these provisions to ex parte and permanent orders.
