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Article 1 PUBLIC HEALTH

Section

- **Establishing fees; definitions.** Amends § 157.16, subd. 3. Provides that youth camps that pay additional food and beverage establishment fees need not pay additional youth camp fees, too.
- Fee revenues. Amends § 214.06 by adding subd. 4. Provides that all fee revenue collected by the health-related licensing boards is deposited into a dedicated account and annually appropriated to the boards. Transfers the current balance in the health-related boards account to the dedicated account. Requires the boards to annually report spending and revenue to the legislature and the public. This section is effective July 1, 2011.
- **Fees, manufactured home parks and recreational camping areas.** Amends § 327.15, subd. 3. Provides that operators of a manufactured home park shall pay only one base fee.
- Food support for children with severe allergies. Directs the commissioner of human services to seek a federal waiver for the supplemental nutrition assistance program in order to increase the income eligibility to 375% of federal poverty guidelines for infants and children in order to treat or manage life-threatening food allergies.
