### Overview

Current law allows payment of water, fuel for heating, electricity, and sewer costs for a structure wholly owned or leased by a fraternal or veteran's organization.

This bill allows payments for a structure partially used for gambling, and partially for other purposes, at the discretion and with the approval of the Director.

#### Section

- 1** **Lawful purpose.** Allows a lawful purpose expenditure for a fraternal or veteran's organization structure in those instances where the structure is not wholly owned or leased for gambling purposes. This is effective the day following final enactment.
