Bill Summary

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Overview

This bill establishes a pilot project in Crow Wing County. Under the pilot, a person who qualifies for the ignition interlock program shall have the option to be monitored by a secure continuous remote alcohol monitor (SCRAM), a portable breath testing (PBT) device, or another monitoring device approved by DPS. The bill requires a preliminary and final report to the legislature on the successes and failures of the pilot, participation and recidivism rates, and recommendations on continuing the project. The pilot expires on June 30, 2013.
