Overview

This bill clarifies the detention placement options available for extended jurisdiction juveniles (EJJ) pending revocation hearings. This language is currently found in rules but not statute. Under Rule 19.11 of the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure, if the offender is under 18, the offender may only be detained in a juvenile facility; and if the offender is 18 or older, the offender may be detained in an adult facility.
