### Overview

This bill creates a new category of school district revenue called explosive growth revenue beginning in fiscal year 2012. A district qualifies for an additional \$500 per pupil of revenue if the district has:

- had at least a four percent pupil growth rate since 2001;
- had a total increase in enrollment of at least 2,900 pupils;
- a total levy where more than half of the levy is from the debt service fund; and
- a total tax rate of more than 40 percent of adjusted net tax capacity (ANTC).

#### Section

**1 Explosive growth revenue.** Creates a new category of general education revenue called explosive growth revenue. Sets the revenue amount equal to \$500 per pupil. Makes the revenue available to any district that has:

- had at least a four percent pupil growth rate since 2001;
- had a total increase in enrollment of at least 2,900 pupils;
- a total levy where more than half of the levy is from the debt service fund; and
- a total tax rate of more than 40 percent of adjusted net tax capacity (ANTC).
