Overview

This bill eliminates regulations under which household goods movers must file a tariff schedule with the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT), which identifies the pricing and fee structure for that mover. It removes associated provisions on rate filing, tariff hearings, petitions, the penalty for violations.

 - (a) Repeals (1) complaint and petition processes concerning filed tariffs, and (2) a misdemeanor penalty established for violation of motor carrier compensation amounts

approved by or filed with MnDOT.

(b) Repeals (1) a requirement that household goods movers file a tariff that identifies their rates and charges for performing moves, (2) an associated provision governing MnDOT hearings on the rates and charges, and (3) a requirement that compensation charged by household goods movers must match the tariff schedule that is on file.

(c) Repeals administrative rules associated with the household goods movers tariff schedule.
