Overview

Modifies provisions related to restroom and meal breaks for employees.

Section

- Rest breaks. Requires employers to allow employees up to 15 minutes time from work to use a restroom within each four consecutive hours of work. Employers with fewer than five employees and operating a retail location do not have to allow 15 minutes, but must allow their employees adequate time to use the nearest readily accessible restroom.
- Meal breaks. Requires employers to allow employees working for at least eight consecutive hours at least 30 minutes time from work to eat a meal. Employers with fewer than five employees and operating a retail location do not have to allow 30 minutes, but must allow their employees sufficient time to eat a meal.
