Overview

A school district may go to the voters to seek approval for an annual levy for a period not to exceed ten years to fund certain capital projects. The ballot question must state the nature of the project, the expected total cost of the project, the expected tax rate necessary to raise the money for the project, and the number of years that the levy will be made.

This bill authorizes a school district to state on the ballot for a renewal of a capital project that the tax rate is unchanged from the previous year and that the project is being renewed.

Section

Capital project levy referendum. Authorizes a school district that is renewing a capital project referendum at the same tax rate to state on the ballot that the capital project is being renewed and that the tax rate is not being increased over the previous year's tax rate.
