Overview

This bill amends the first-degree DWI crime to include prior felony convictions from another state in conformity with Minnesota's law. Under Minnesota law, a person is guilty of first-degree DWI if the person: (1) commits the violation within ten years of three or more DWI violations; (2) has previously been convicted of a felony DWI; or (3) has previously been convicted of felony CVO (criminal vehicular operation).
