Overview

This is the 2010 Omnibus Liquor Bill

Section

- Sale of liquors. [Atkins, HF 2974] Allows the State Fair, rather than Ramsey County, to issue licenses for beer and Minnesota-produced wine.
- **Special provision; city of Minneapolis. [HF 2903 Wagenius]** Allows an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to be issued to the Museum of Russian Art.
- Wine licenses. [HF 2974 Atkins] Allows state fair wine licenses for concessionaires.
- Insurance required. [Commerce Committee Amendment] Clarifies dram shop joint underwriting standards pursuant to a recent Supreme Court case -- Brua v. Minnesota Joint Underwriting Association. Incorporates the Supreme Court decision.
- 5 **Insurance not required. [Commerce Committee Amendment•** Exempts wholesalers who donate wine to an organization for a wine tasting from the requirement that dram shop insurance is required.
- Tastings conducted by exclusive liquor store. [HF 3481 Hoppe] Allows spirits or malt liquor tastings to be conducted; subjects malt liquor tastings to existing laws on wholesaler provision.
- **Authorization.** [HF 2974 Atkins] Allows the State Fair to license and regulate retail tobacco sales on the State Fairgrounds.
- **8 City of Minneapolis; liquor license. [HF 3186 Atkins**] Technical fix from last year's revisor bill.
- 9 University of St. Thomas; on-sale license. [HF 2973, E. Murphy] Allows St. Thomas University to be issued a liquor license by Minneapolis and St. Paul.

- **Bemidji Regional Center; on-sale license. [HF 3235 Persell]** Allows the Bemidji Regional Center to have an on-sale license.
- **Exemption; Bemidji State University.** Exempts Bemidji State University from a requirement that no more than one temporary license be give in a 30 day period.
