

meetings. Requires the task force to meet at least monthly.

(d) Directs the education commissioner to assist the task force upon request.

(e) Does not allow task force members to receive compensation or reimbursement of expenses for their service on the task force.

Subd. 2. Duties; report. (a) Directs the task force to develop recommendations and legislation for amending Minnesota's school desegregation rule and the law governing the use and allocation of the state's integration revenue. Allows the recommendations to address: access to integrated and equitable learning environments; the changing demographics of Minnesota students; cultural proficiency training for teachers; the impact of school choice laws on school desegregation and integration; financial and other resources available to school districts to provide staff development training, magnet schools, and other interdistrict collaborative efforts to enhance student achievement.

(b) Directs the task force to submit its recommendations and legislation to the legislature by January 15, 2011.

Subd. 3. Expiration. Causes the task force to expire on January 16, 2011.

Makes this section effective immediately.
