## Overview

Modifies state building code requirements related to lead clean up.

Section

- 1 Lead poisoning prevention. Adds a requirement to the state building code that remodeling performed on residential property or child-occupied facilities constructed prior to 1978, comply with federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) standards.
- 2 **Pre-1978 structures.** Requires firms who perform work on residential or child-occupied structures constructed prior to 1978 be certified to perform lead work under the EPA regulations. Requires the Department of Labor and Industry to provide a Web link to the EPA for verification of contractor certification
- **3 Pre-1978 structures.** Requires firms doing renovation to comply with the requirements of section 2.
