### Overview

Basic education revenue for each district equals the product of the formula allowance multiplied by the adjusted marginal cost pupil units for the school year. Adjusted marginal cost pupil units is a statutorily defined count of pupils in daily attendance. The basic formula allowance for the 2009-2010 school year and later is \$5,124 per adjusted marginal cost pupil unit.

This bill removes obsolete language from the general education basic formula allowance.
