



services for homeless persons, as provided in Minnesota Statutes §256E.36, and 50 percent be distributed to Hunger Solutions, a nonprofit statewide association of foodshelves, as provided in Minnesota Statutes §256E.34. Provides that all interest earned on amounts in the account accrues to the account. Pledges that the state will use amounts deposited in the accounts for the purposes specified. Requires that amounts contributed through the checkoff be used to supplement and not substitute for traditional funding for food shelves and homeless services. Effective beginning in tax year 2010.
