Overview

Currently, wine tastings are the only legal and allowed tastings in Minnesota. This bill also allows malt liquor and spirits tastings to be conducted.

Section

- 1 Wine tastings conducted by exclusive liquor store.** Adds malt liquor and spirits to the kinds of alcohol that can be used in tastings. [The headnote needs to be amended as a technical amendment.] Malt liquor tastings are subjected to current law requirements about wholesaler-retailer beer samples, and the provision of malt liquor for those samples.
