Overview

Currently, wine tastings are the only legal and allowed tastings in Minnesota. This bill also allows malt liquor and spirits tastings to be conducted.

Section

Wine tastings conducted by exclusive liquor store. Adds malt liquor and spirits to the kinds of alcohol that can be used in tastings. [The headnote needs to be amended as a technical amendment.] Malt liquor tastings are subjected to current law requirements about wholesaler-retailer beer samples, and the provision of malt liquor for those samples.
