Overview

A number of activities are listed in the bill as constituting an examination subversion practice. Generally, these activities include cheating on an exam, taking exam questions or materials from the testing room, and the unauthorized distribution, sale, or purchase of exam questions. A person damaged or likely to be damaged by an examination subversion practice is entitled to seek an injunction in court to prevent the activity from occurring, and to recover damages resulting from activities that have already occurred.
