Extends the probationary period for peace officers governed by the municipal civil service statute, Minnesota Statutes, chapter 44, from six months to 12 months. The probationary period for other employees in the municipality remains six months. Effective the day after enactment and applies to peace officers hired under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 44, on or after that date.

According to the testimony, this affects the cities of New Hope and East Grand Forks.
