Increases the penalty for possessing, storing, or keeping a dangerous weapon while knowingly on school property from a two to a five-year penalty.

Decreases the penalty for using or brandishing a replica firearm or BB gun while knowingly on school property from a two-year felony to a gross misdemeanor.

Decreases the penalty for possessing, storing, or keeping a replica firearm or a BB gun on school property from a gross misdemeanor to a misdemeanor.

A gross misdemeanor is punishable by up to a year in jail and a misdemeanor is punishable by up to 90 days in jail.
