Overview

This bill authorizes the state to sell and issue \$400,000 in general obligation bonds to construct, furnish and equip a building on the campus of the Minnesota State Academy for the Blind to provide housing for students 18 to 21 years of age who are attending college classes or working, have not yet received their high school diploma and whose individual education plans (IEPs) are not yet completed.

The Minnesota State Academy for the Blind is a residential academy located in Faribault serving approximately 50 students.

- 1 Minnesota State Academy for the Blind; housing for 18 to 21 year old students.**
Authorizes the state to sell and issue \$400,000 in general obligation bonds to construct, furnish and equip a building on the campus of the Minnesota State Academy for the Blind to provide housing for students aged 18 to 21 who are either attending college classes or working and who have not yet completed their high school diploma or completed the conditions of their respective IEPs. Appropriates \$400,000 for the project from the state bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of administration.
