## Overview

## Section

1 Possession of crossbows. Amends § 97B.035, subdivision 2. Removes the bow case requirements for crossbows outdoors or in motor vehicles during the open season for any game.

Possession of firearms and ammunition restricted in deer zones. Amends § 97B.041. Removes the gun case requirements for a firearm outdoors during the period beginning the fifth day before the open firearms deer season and ending the second day after the close of the season.

Restrictions. Amends § 97B.045, subdivision 1. Removes existing gun case requirements by allowing a person to transport an unloaded firearm (except for pistols as defined under § 624.712, subdivision 2 ) in a motor vehicle without being cased unless: within the boundaries of a city, town, county, or other government subdivision that prohibits the discharge of a firearm; or restricted under § 97A. 091 (existing restriction while on game refuges), § 97B. 081 (existing restriction while using artificial lights ("shining")), or § 97B. 086 (existing restrictions while using night vision equipment).

4 Transportation of archery bows. Amends § 97B.051. Removes existing casing requirements for bows provided they are not armed.

5 Possession on school property; penalty. Amends § 609.66, subdivision 1d. Technical correction needed to preserve gun and bow case requirements on school grounds.
