## Overview

This bill requires a business establishment that sells OTC meth precursor drugs to retain the sale log for three years. The log contains information on the date of sale, the name of the buyer, and the amount of the drug sold. In addition, the bill requires the business to allow inspection of the log by law enforcement at all reasonable times. A knowing violation of this section is a misdemeanor (maximum penalty of 90 days' imprisonment and/or \$1,000 fine).
