Overview

H.F. 166 prohibits commercial retailers from selling any toy designed primarily for use by children under age 12 that has been recalled for safety related reasons by the federal government or the toy's manufacturer, wholesaler, distributor, or importer. Clarifies that "recalled" does not include corrective actions that involve safety alerts, parts replacement, or consumer repairs. Enforcement would be covered by the "Safe Toys Act" currently in statute. Effective August 1, 2009.
