Overview

H.F. 166 prohibits commercial retailers from selling any toy that has been recalled for safety related reasons by the federal government or the toy's manufacturer, wholesaler, distributor, or importer. The prohibition would not apply to toys whose recall has been rescinded. Enforcement would be covered by the "Safe Toys Act" currently in statute. Effective August 1, 2009.
