The bill expands required use of a child passenger restraint system, to require it (in vehicles that have seatbelts) when transporting a child who is (1) under age eight, and (2) under four feet nine inches tall. Under current law, a child passenger restraint system is required to transport children who are under age four, after which age the child is required to wear a seatbelt.
