Overview

Allows school districts to decide to pay for mandated and discretionary background checks on prospective employees and other individuals who seek to enter a school or its grounds.

Section

- **Background check required.** (a) Allows a school hiring authority to pay the costs of conducting a mandated criminal history background check on prospective employees and coaches.
 - (c) Allows a school hiring authority to pay the costs of conducting a discretionary criminal history background check on school volunteers, independent contractors, and student employees.
 - (d) Allows a school hiring authority to pay the costs of conducting a mandated criminal history background check on prospective employees who are nonstate residents.
