Overview

Allows the public safety commissioner to approve driver instruction materials for students, including home school students, that are offered in online courses.

1 Driver education content. (d) Allows the public safety commissioner to approve driver instruction materials offered in online courses that: (1) are incorporated within the classroom-phase of instruction of a public, private, or commercial driver education program or home school education program; (2) include a maximum of six hours of online instruction in a 30-hour program; (3) provide actual student-to-teacher contact or communication; (4) offer required curriculum; (5) focus on driver's manual content; and (6) include a process for verifying student participation.
