Overview

This bill authorizes the state to sell and issue \$2.33 million in general obligation bonds to construct a geothermal heating system for the Dawson school complex. The Dawson-Boyd school district is located in the western part of the state and serves approximately 525 students.

Section

Dawson-Boyd School District; geothermal heating. Authorizes the commissioner of finance to sell and issue \$2.33 million in general obligation bonds. Appropriates \$2.33 million from the state bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of education for a grant to the Dawson-Boyd school district to predesign, design, acquire, construct and install a geothermal heating system for the Dawson school building. Defines the geothermal heating project to include asbestos abatement, installation of a sprinkler system, and fresh air ventilation upgrades.
