Overview

This bill creates a lifesaver program to help assist lifesaver response programs, which are designed to quickly find individuals with medical conditions that cause them to go missing.

Section

1 Lifesaver Grant Program.

Subd. 1. Program assistance. Directs the commissioner of public safety to assist local law enforcement agencies with the development of lifesaver rapid response programs designed to quickly find individuals with medical conditions that cause them to go missing. The program would involve electronic tracking via wristband transmitters. The commissioner shall promote the program statewide and serve as the liaison for local programs.

- **Subd. 2. Lifesaver advisory task force.** Directs the commissioner to convene a voluntary lifesaver task force of at least five members to facilitate the coordination and implementation of lifesaver programs. Specifies what experience members of the task force should possess.
- **Subd. 3. Report to legislature.** Requires the commissioner to report to the legislature by January 15, 2012, on the status of lifesaver programs in the state.
