Overview

This bill modifies 24-hour customized living services.

Section

- 1 Service rate limits; 24-hour customized living services.** Amends § 256B.0915, subd. 3h. Specifies the types of providers and facilities in which 24-hour customized living services are delivered. Allows home care providers with a capacity to serve 12 or fewer clients to provide nighttime supervision to clients using personnel who have other duties and are located in an adjoining building if certain conditions are met.
