This bill expands the school bus accident reporting requirement for peace officers. The bill requires a peace officer who responds to an accident involving a school bus to report the accident to the State Patrol if there is:

- 1) a fatality;
- 2) a bodily injury to a person who requires immediate medical treatment; or
- 3) a vehicle involved in the accident that suffers disabling damage.

Failure to comply with this reporting requirement is a misdemeanor.
