This bill requires the criminal and juvenile justice information policy group to study the feasibility of collecting and reporting summary data relating to the decisions that affect a child's status within the juvenile justice system. The study must consider data to be collected, the decision points at which data must be collected, agencies required to supply the data, the repository for data, frequency of reporting, an implementation plan, and the costs. A report is due to the legislature by February 15, 2010.
