Overview

Requires the notice to state that the screening helps the district identify children who may benefit from available community resources and that the vision screening, while helpful, is not a substitute for a comprehensive eye exam.

Screening program. Requires the parent notice about the early childhood development screening program to state that the screening: helps the district identify children who may benefit from district and community resources available to help with their development; and includes a vision screening that may help detect potential eye problems but is not a substitute for a comprehensive eye exam.
